



State Mullet Festival - Swansboro Mullet Festival

In 2012, the General Assembly named the Swansboro Mullet Festival as the official mullet festival of the State of North Carolina. The Swansboro Mullet Festival became the official State Mullet Festival in June of 2013.

The Swansboro Mullet Festival began in 1954 when local mullet fishermen held a fish fry to celebrate the opening of a new bridge in town. The tradition continued, and now the festival is held on the second weekend of October every year.
